1. The undersigned ("**Owner**", whether one or more) certifies, as of the Effective Date, his/her/their ownership of the decimal interest in production or proceeds as described herein payable to Warren E&P, Inc. ("**Payor**").
2. No change in the ownership, decimal interest or payment address claimed by or attributable to Owner hereunder shall be binding on Payor until Payor has been notified of such change in writing and in a form satisfactory to Payor and the writing has been delivered to Payor at the address shown above. Regardless of the effective date of the writing, if any, no such change will be effective for purposes of this Division Order until 7:00 A.M. on the first day of the month following Payor's receipt of the notification. At no time shall Owner have any obligation to independently determine if and when any future, limited legal, equitable, reversionary, defeasible or contingent interest claimed by Owner shall vest, terminate or change.
3. If any title dispute or adverse claim arises with respect to the interest in production claimed herein by Owner, Payor is authorized to withhold payment pending resolution of such dispute to Payor's satisfaction. If any legal action or lawsuit is filed in any court affecting the interest in production claimed herein by Owner, Owner shall immediately provide written notice thereof to Payor along with copies of all relevant pleadings.
4. Owner shall reimburse Payor for any funds paid to Owner hereunder to which Owner was not entitled, and Owner shall indemnify and hold harmless Payor against any liability, loss, damage or expense (including litigation costs and attorney's fees) that Payor may incur as a result of such wrongful payment.

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5. Settlements hereunder shall be made monthly by check mailed or delivered to Owner or Owner's designee at the address above, during the calendar month next following the calendar month in which Payor has taken delivery of oil or gas or has received payment therefor; provided that to avoid the inconvenience of small checks, Payor may withhold payments to Owner without interest until the total amount accrued to Owner is at least \$100.00.
6. This Division Order shall continue in full force and effect until Payor or Owner gives written notice of termination to the other whereupon the Division Order shall terminate at 7:00 A.M. on the first day of the second calendar month following the calendar month in which such notice is received.
7. This Division Order shall be effective as to each Owner that executes the same, whether or not other parties designated herein as "Owner" have also signed.
